## **PCR Test Requirements for Returning Korean Citizens**

## **Background**

To prevent the spread of the new Covid19 variants, South Korea has strengthened anti-infection measures to returning Korean citizens.

## **Updates**

South Korean citizens who fall under the below conditions are required to get a PCR test within 72 hours before departure to South Korea. They must need to bring their Covid19-negative test result certificate with them when coming to South Korea to show it to airport quarantine officers. A PCR test certificate must be issued either in English or Korean from a local hospital in the departure city.

South Korean citizens who fall under the above conditions but coming without a valid PCR test certificate will be subject to do 2 weeks of quarantine at one of the government quarantine facilities and need to pay the fees to use government quarantine facility, which will be 1.7~2.1 million KRW per person.
