## Those who have registered vaccination records in South Korea will be exempted from two weeks of quarantine when entering the country next time

### Newly implemented policy: Register vaccination record in South Korea

Effective from the week of October 12, 2021, those who enter South Korea with a valid Quarantine Exemption Certificate (QEC) can register their vaccination record at the Korean government's system by visiting a district public health center after arriving in South Korea.

To register your vaccination record, you need to bring your vaccination certificate issued in English from the country where you got vaccinated & your QEC issued from the Korean government authority. Please ensure to bring printed copies when visiting a district public health center for your vaccination record registration.

As a third party is not allowed to apply for vaccination record registration on behalf, please contact the Central Disease Control Headquarters at +82 43 719 8376 for more information.

### Benefit

If entrants can meet all the below-listed conditions, they will be exempted from a 2-weeks quarantine without obtaining QEC:

- Successfully completed register their vaccination record at the Korean government's system by visiting a public health center in South Korea.
- Do not have any suspected Covid19-related symptoms.
- Do not come from one of the countries designated by the Korean government as high-risk countries of Covid19 variants.

### High-risk countries of Covid19 variants

The Korean government announces a list of high risk Covid19 variant countries monthly. As of October 2021, total 20 countries are on this list:

*Namibia, South Africa, Malawi, Mozambique, Myanmar, Bangladesh, Brazil, Surinam, Angola, Uzbekistan, Indonesia, Zambia, Djibouti, Chile, Kazakhstan, Kyrgyzstan, Trinidad and Tobago, Pakistan, Peru, Philippines.*
