Getting a Visa for working in Taiwan



Work permit – Apply by Taiwan Company (employer), the professional foreigner should meet Taiwan basic requirements of education & work experience.



Authentication – Diploma / marriage / birth certificates authentication is requested in the process.

Entering Taiwan legally and making sure you are operating within the proper sphere is the concern of any company or individual trying to do business in Taiwan. Navigating the legal framework and permissions of the various visa types can be daunting, which is why we have prepared below the basic details. Note: Hong Kong, Macau and Mainland China passport holders will require different process instead of below introduction.



Resident Visa – After work permit issued, resident visa need to apply in home country. However, some nationals can use visa-exempt to enter Taiwan instead.



Alien Permanent Resident Certificate (APRC) – After 5 years residency and match government requirements, foreigner can get APRC for permanent residency.

Alien Resident Certificate (ARC) – After enter Taiwan by resident visa, ARC should be applied ASAP.



Work permit, visa and ARC process will take 4-8 weeks, so make sure you start ASAP!
