

## IMPORTANT NOTICE

### Summary – Entry Restrictions

- ✘ Travelers prohibited from entry to Taiwan
- ◆ Travelers with a history of travel (including transit via) to China, Hong Kong, and Macau; are required to be under mandatory 14-days home quarantine after entering Taiwan. As of 25 Feb 2020, this includes entry to Taiwan via South Korea.
- \* Travelers entering Taiwan via Thailand, Italy, Iran, Singapore, and Japan will be subject to mandatory 14-days self-health management protocol; travelers entering to Taiwan via South Korea will be subject to mandatory 14-days home quarantine protocol.

#### Mandatory Home Quarantine Protocol:

1. Stay at home or place of accommodation. You are forbidden from leaving the house/place of accommodation or leaving the country and going abroad.
2. Please live in a separate room and keep away from your family at a distance of at least 1 meter. Also, the people living with you should take protective measures (wearing surgical masks and maintaining good hygiene practices).
3. Please record your temperature and health status. The health authority will follow up on your record daily.
4. Please keep your hands clean. You should wash your hands with soap or alcohol-based hand sanitizers frequently. Also, please refrain from touching your eyes, nose, and mouth with your hands. If your hands touch any secretions from your respiratory tract, please wash your hands with soap and water thoroughly.
5. When you display symptoms, such as fever, cough, and breathing difficulties, please notify the authorities or dial 1922. The competent authority will arrange for you to seek medical attention, please wear a mask and take appropriate protective measures on the way and do not take public transportation.

6. The immigration agency will be notified by the computer system when you are placed on home quarantine. Thus, when you need to go abroad after home quarantine ends, please bring the notice form with you. Please show immigration officers the notice form for fear that they may delay your clearance due to the time error of the system.

※ Those who violate the home quarantine regulations and leave the house or take public transportation will be fined, ranging from NT\$150,000 to NT\$300,000 per Article 58 and 69 of the Communicable Disease Control Act.

Mandatory Self-health Management Protocol:

- Keep hands clean and maintain regular handwashing habits. Also, be careful not to touch your eyes, nose, and mouth directly with your hands. When your hands come into contact with respiratory secretions, please wash your hands with soap and water and clean thoroughly
- Take body temperature twice a day in the morning & night and keep a detailed record of your body temperature and activities.
- If you don't have any symptoms, you can live normally, but you should try to avoid going in and out of public places. When you go out, you must strictly abide by wearing surgical masks.
- If you have a fever, respiratory symptoms, or physical discomfort, make sure to wear a surgical mask and consult a doctor as soon as possible. When you seek medical treatment, you should take the initiative to inform the physician of your contact history, travel history, residence history, occupational exposure, and whether anyone else close to you who has similar symptoms.
- During the illness, you should take a rest at home, wear surgical masks, and avoid going out. When the mask comes into contact with oral and nasal secretions, it should be replaced immediately and folded into the trash.
- When talking to others during the illness, keep a distance of at least 1 meter apart, and wear a surgical mask.
