

Country list update on mandatory home quarantine

All travelers from 29 countries / Regardless of nationality

From 17 March 2020, all travelers from the Schengen area, United Kingdom, Ireland, and Dubai must undergo compulsory 14-days home quarantine.

The Schengen Area consists of 26 member countries. All these countries are in Europe, including four countries which are not members of the European Union. The Schengen Area member countries are:

Austria, Belgium, Czech Republic, Denmark, Estonia, Finland, France, Germany, Greece, Hungary, Iceland, Italy, Latvia, Liechtenstein, Lithuania, Luxembourg, Malta, Netherlands, Norway, Poland, Portugal, Slovakia, Slovenia, Spain, Sweden, and Switzerland.

Home quarantine

Individuals in-home quarantine are not allowed to leave their place of residence for two weeks, and they will receive daily health checks from local medical authorities twice per day.

Penalties on home quarantine violation

The Taiwanese government will levy the highest penalty on those who violate the home quarantine rules. Penalties include mandatory medical isolation and fines ranging from NT\$10,000 to NT\$300,000 under the Communicable Disease Control Act.
